Dear Fundraising Event Hosts:

Thank you for being willing to lend your support to Ashland Pregnancy Care Center (APCC) by serving as a host for this year's 40th Anniversary Celebration Fundraising Event.

Prayer is essential in all that we do. On Tuesday, March 30, I am asking you to make time to come together between 6:00-7:30pm for a Prayer Walk (come when you can, leave when you must.) Along with board, staff, and volunteers, we will pray for the Lord's blessing on this year's fundraising event and other prayer concerns (see detailed sheet enclosed). Please see the enclosed postcard invitation for all the details of the Prayer Walk.

We are very excited to be celebrating our 40th year in ministry, so we've decided to make this year's fundraising event extra special. Our "40th Anniversary Celebration Fundraising Event" will be on Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at Calvary Baptist Church located at 210 Davis Rd., Ashland, OH at 7:30 p.m. Our theme, "Celebrate Miraeles" is based on Matthew 19:26 which says: "With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible." We have seen God working in mighty ways. Through faithful supporters like you, God has not only met all our needs, but has blessed us more than we could ask or imagine. We know all things ARE possible with Him.

We plan to reach over 1,000 people with our "hybrid" fundraising event and believe that we will sell out the in-person event at 650 guests. Your involvement is essential! I know that you rejoice right along with us over last year's record (virtual) attendance of over 850 individuals. Last year we raised over \$133,000 for LIFE. Our goal for 2021 is raise over \$150,000, as we celebrate 40 years in ministry!

Due to the number of expected attendees, we will NOT be serving a meal during the fundraising event so that we can provide the maximum number of seats. The event will also be live-streamed for those who wish to watch online. This "hybrid event" will be a new opportunity to share our mission with more people than ever before.

The fundraising event is essential in keeping our doors open. The monies given ensure that we receive the necessary day to day funding so that we may continue providing pregnancy testing, ultrasound confirmation of pregnancy, support and education while developing relationships, and sharing the love of Christ with clients.

The night of the fundraising event, <u>please arrive by 6:45 p.m. and enter through the first set of outside doors labeled</u> "GYMNASIUM" (These are the doors with the steeple). A volunteer will greet you and check you in at the doors. Promptly at 6:50 p.m. we will go over instructions and have a brief time of prayer. You will then go to your rows which will allow you to greet your guests when the doors open at 7:00 p.m.

1. Please note: Everyone that attended the Virtual Banquet in 2020 will receive an invitation in the mail. In the event one of your invited, confirmed guests should also mail in an RSVP card – rest assured that we will adjust their reservation accordingly. Your packet contains one (1) printed invitation. You are welcome to send when inviting those who have never attended an APCC fundraising event or have not attended in the last few years. Or, please invite your guests online. Please contact APCC if you need additional invitations.

- 2. Prayerfully consider and then personally invite your guests. We encourage you to invite those who may have *never* attended one of APCC's fundraising events as well as "veteran" attendees. Doing so helps to "grow" the event and increases the potential of adding new donors and making our donor base even stronger. See the enclosed sheet titled "Who should I invite..." for more help.
- 3. The main purpose of the evening is fund-raising Adults only please, as limited seating is available.
- 4. Make sure your guests understand that there is no charge for them to come, but that this is a <u>fund-raising</u> event. Don't be afraid to ask them to bring their checkbooks. APCC is a ministry funded by many people who are not necessarily wealthy, but have a heart and commitment to the ministry.
- 5. *NEW THIS YEAR— Due to the number of expected attendees, we will NOT be serving a meal during the fundraising event so that we can provide the maximum number of seats. The event will also be live-streamed for those who wish to watch online. This "hybrid event" (in-person and virtual option) will be a new opportunity to share our mission with more people than ever before.

 ***For those who cannot attend the night of the event, the REPLAY will be available for up to 45 days AFTER the event date.
- 6. **Each ROW will seat a minimum of 4 people up to a max of 12 people** including you. Please feel free to invite more than one row-full. If you are hosting a "virtual" party invite as many guests as you would like!
- 7. Please register your in-person guests by **Tuesday**, **April 13**, **2021** as seating is limited. If you are unable to fill a row, we can assist filling open seats with guests who do not yet have a row host. We anticipate a sold out crowd!
- 8. REGISTRATION PROCESS: ONLINE OR USE GUEST LIST FORM IN YOUR PACKET
 - ONLINE REGISTRATION: We want to encourage you to invite guests through our online event registration system (Ministry Sync).
 You can invite guests, register guests, and manage your group online. First, you need register yourself as a host first.
 Once registered, you will receive an email confirmation. Then, follow the prompts in your email to mange your guest list.

We anticipate that there will be a wait list to attend the in-person event (as seating is limited).
- 11. Call and remind your guests two (2) days before the fundraising event, to reconfirm their reservation.

Pray as we invite – As we consider who to ask, let's make each invitation a matter of prayer. God might show us someone with an open heart in the most unlikely places. As we are open to His direction, we look forward to His hand leading us to the right people with a joyful desire to take this ministry exactly where God wants us to go.

MEET GUEST SPEAKER

Abby Johnson

All Abby Johnson ever wanted to do was help women. Her passion surrounding a woman's right to choose even led her to become a spokesperson for Planned Parenthood, fighting to enact legislation for the cause she so deeply believed in.

It was this conviction that both led Abby to a career with Planned Parenthood, and caused her to flee the organization and become an outspoken advocate for the pro-life movement. During her eight years with Planned Parenthood, Abby quickly rose in the organization's ranks and became a clinic director. As one of the youngest Planned Parenthood clinic directors in the nation, she was involved in upwards of 22,000 abortions and counseled countless women about their reproductive choices. However, Abby became increasingly disturbed by what she witnessed. Abortion was a product Planned Parenthood was selling, not an unfortunate necessity that they fought to decrease.

Her life was changed on September 26, 2009, when Abby was asked to assist with an ultrasound-guided abortion. She watched in horror as a 13-week baby fought, and ultimately lost, its life at the hand of the abortionist. At that moment, the full realization of what abortion was and what she had dedicated her life occurred to Abby and a dramatic transformation took place.

Desperate and confused, Abby sought help from a local pro-life group. She swore that she would begin to advocate for life in the womb and expose abortion for what it truly is.

Planned Parenthood is fully aware that the workers who leave are their greatest threat. They took immediate action to silence Abby with a gag order and brought her to court. The lawsuit was ultimately thrown out of court.

The media continues to be interested in Abby's story as well as her continued efforts to advocate for the unborn and help clinic workers escape the abortion industry. She is a frequently requested guest on Fox News and a variety of other shows. She also the author of the nationally best-selling book, Unplanned, which chronicles both her experiences within Planned Parenthood and her dramatic exit.

The book has become the movie Unplanned. From Cary Solomon and Chuck Konzelman, the writers/co-producers of God's Not Dead, comes a film that speaks to one of the most polarizing topics of our day. Unplanned brings us an eye-opening look inside the abortion industry from a woman who was once its most passionate advocate. After reading Abby Johnson's best-selling book of the same title, Cary and Chuck were moved to bring this inspiring true story to the big screen, giving voice to a woman who has been on both sides of the abortion conversation.

Today, Abby travels across the globe sharing her story, educating the public on pro-life issues, advocating for the unborn, and reaching out to abortion clinic staff who still work in the industry. She is the founder of And Then There Were None, a ministry designed to assist abortion clinic workers in transitioning out of the industry. To date, this ministry has helped over 550 workers leave the abortion industry. Abby lives in Texas with her husband and eight precious children.
