Tuesday, April 20, 2021, was definitely an evening to remember! Our 40th Anniversary Celebration Fundraising Event at Calvary Baptist Church was an incredible experience for the more than 400 people who attended. It was wonderful to once again see you all in person. We hope you enjoyed our time together.

Guest speaker Abby Johnson shared the transformation God performed in her heart, causing her to leave her career at Planned Parenthood and take a stand for the unborn. Hearing her story brought tears to many eyes and revealed the truth of the spiritual battle that is evident in our world today.

City of Ashland mayor, Matt Miller, served as the Master of Ceremonies and spoke of how APCC has been faithful to the pro-life cause for 40 years.

Unable to attend in person, Senator Rob Portman offered his congratulations virtually on the accomplishments of APCC and his

intention to continue to support the prolife movement in Washington DC.

Melanie shared recent updates to the facility, including new flooring, paint, furniture, and technology. After donning her rubber boots, she took us on a virtual tour to show the basement, which was several inches under water.

The vision for the fall is to add the Abortion Pill Reversal/Rescue, and in the spring of 2022 expand to offer STD/STI services and treatment. Melanie impressed on the crowd why it's essential to expand services to meet community needs.

Through your faithfulness, many needs have already been met.

We are so are excited to report that we more than exceeded our \$150,000 goal. To date, YOU helped us raise \$196,972 in one-time gifts and monthly support-that is nearly a 48% increase from last year! This is more than we've ever raised at our annual event, thanks to

Our 40th Anniversary Celebration was truly spectacular! The evening was beyond special and blessed. Abby stirred many hearts and the financial resources were greater than we ever anticipated. Why wouldn't we seek our Abba Father for direction? Let me give you two examples. At the banquet, I shared of our continual problem we have had in the Center's basement for years. After praying and sharing the need, God provided the knowledgeable individual and resources to fix this problem once and for all. I also shared a desire of our heart - to upgrade to a large 50-inch flat screen TV in our ultrasound room so that the miracle of life would be more visible to a mom considering abortion. After much prayer and determination, God used a woman in the community as an answer to our prayers who donated a 50-inch flat screen TV. Since the installation of the TV, we have had multiple young women who had abortion appointments scheduled who saw their baby via ultrasound at our Center and If you haven't been in to see us, please have been greatly moved by the movement and heartbeat. I am humbled to share that these ladies have canceled their abortion appointments, and each have chosen life!

Friends, what a mighty We praise God and give Him glory! Our ministry not only exists to protect the sanctity of human life and to offer compassion, hope, and help to women and men facing critical pregnancy decisions, but our mission is also to bring honor and glory to God in all that we do.

> We know that God has been faithful in the past, in the present, and will be in the future. As we look ahead, our vision is to expand our reach in the community and surrounding area. We believe God has uniquely positioned us in this community, which is located within an hour's drive of abortion facilities to the north, south, and east. God has called us to launch Abortion Pill Rescue (Reversal), so that a woman may know that hope is available and it may not be too late to save her pregnancy if she has started the chemical abortion.

> Our dream is still to unite the ministries of Ashland Pregnancy Care Center under one roof. Until God makes the path clear, we are staying the course and remaining faithful to our mission, right where He has us. We wanted to share that we recently sold the land at Amberwood Parkway and set aside the funds for a future home for APCC.
