KAILEE PERRIN-HAVING A BABY CHANGED HER LIFE

On Sunday, January 19, 2020, Ashland Pregnancy Care Center presented the Sanctity of Human Life Sunday Community Service hosted by New Life Community Church. The evening consisted of praise and worship led by a community worship team (worship leaders from various churches), Scripture readings, and prayer. Special guest speaker was Kailee Perrin.

Kailee shared her powerful testimony of redemption. In 2008, Kailee found herself addicted to drugs and alcohol, and pregnant. After telling her boyfriend, who at the time was a drug dealer, and whom she had only known a short time, he encouraged her to get an abortion. "Deep down, I wanted to be a mom. I wanted to be able to change," she said. "But those lies that the enemy feeds women about abortion became so loud."

Being worried about how she would provide for a baby, Kailee relayed that she was not unlike other women in local churches and communities who find themselves in similar situations. With God's intervention, Kailee went to a local pregnancy center (thinking they did abortions). When she arrived at the pregnancy center, she felt peace, love, and hope. Kailee chose life for her baby, and later gave her life to Jesus.

APCC Executive Director Melanie Miller reiterated the vital role the local church plays in the lives of women and men facing an unexpected pregnancy.
