# A Message from the Executive Director - "Anything is Possible"

Do you believe in miracles? I sure do! I believe in the power of prayer. I believe God is a good Father and he desires to do good to his children. When I ponder the start of the ministry of Ashland Pregnancy Care Center, which began 40 years ago—I am in awe of God's faithfulness and His provision.

Consider the humble beginnings of the Ashland Pregnancy Care Center. A small group of people from Grace Church decide they want to do something to end abortion in our community. So in 1981,

our ministry began as Ashland Crisis Pregnancy Center utilizing a single room in Andrews Hall at Ashland College (now Ashland University). Today, we continue to enjoy significant growth in client services.

On Sunday, January 17, 2021, Ashland Pregnancy Care Center presented the Sanctity of Human Life Sunday Community Prayer Service hosted by Grace Church. The evening consisted of praise and worship led by the Grace worship team, Scripture readings, and 3 prayer movements (a time for celebration & praise, repentance & healing, and hope and challenge.) There were a total of 7 prayer focuses lead by pastors and ministry leaders including: praise for APCC celebrating 40 years of ministry; miracle of life; repentance and awakening - sin of abortion; elected officials, legislation, and soul of our nation; healing - post abortion, loss of child & those who hope for children; sanctity of marriage and family; and for pastors and the church. - ▼ APCC finished 2020 in a strong financial position (record income in a pandemic year!), with the funds to pay off the center's mortgage, therefore moving us into 2021 debt free!
- Since 1981, more than 2,000 babies have been saved from abortion through APCC!
