

DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

The giant "non-profit" Planned Parenthood tells us that its mission involves promoting "choice" for everyone and "every child a wanted child". Sounds noble, doesn't it?

But what is the truth? According to Planned Parenthood's own 2010 report (it's most recent) the truth is - in 2010, America's leading abortion provider gave us 329,445 abortions and more than 1.4 million doses of "emergency contraception." "Emergency contraception," of course, is an attempt to induce an abortion in case fertilization has taken place.

And yet, Planned Parenthood tells us they are focused on providing so many other pregnancy-related services. Really? Their own numbers tell us that in only 31,058 instances did they provide *any* prenatal care. Adoption referrals? A whopping 841 nationwide.

So, out of 1,823,070 pregnancy-related appointments at Planned Parenthood, 98.2% of their services were either abortions or abortion attempts. The more difficult truth perhaps, is that our tax dollars fund Planned Parenthood. Nearly half of Planned Parenthoods \$1 billion (yes that's billion with a 'b') comes from us – the American tax-payers, in the form of grants and reimbursements. That works out to \$1.47 from each man, woman and child in the United States.
