Ashland Care Center has moved from being a small organization that provides pregnancy tests and some counseling to being a much larger-scale organization able to offer many more medical and supportive services to its clients. We are a recognized presence in the Ashland Community and this past year has been totally amazing! God is doing a great thing in Ashland, Ohio, through Ashland Care Center!

2012 brought a 14.4% increase in the number of total clients and a 75.9% increase in client visits at ACC. These are incredi-

ble numbers that show we ARE making a difference in the lives of mothers, fathers, and children in our community. This difference is not only being made through the increased services we offer but through the dedicated work of our



staff and volunteers who work hard to develop lasting and meaningful Christian relationships with our clients. A huge debt of gratitude goes to these dear individuals.

God also has blessed us in our finances. Who would have dreamed that we would end the year 2012 with a balance of almost \$45,000? But God provided, starting with a record attendance at last year's annual banquet fund-raiser and a record amount of generous donations made that evening. And He kept on providing for our needs throughout the year in many unexpected ways and at many unexpected times. The increase in funds has given us breathing room and allowed us to hire two new (and needed!) staff persons to meet the increased requirements of serving more clients.
