To eliminate the confusion, our board believes that combining these names will provide greater clarity for those who wonder who we are and what we do.

First off moving forward, we will now do business as ASHLAND PREGNANCY CARE CENTER. That says it all! Clients come to us for pregnancy help, but we do more than just pregnancy testing and ultrasounds. We *care* about each individual's physical, emotional, and spiritual needs. We *care* about seeing families thrive. We *care* about where they will spend eternity. We *care* about seeing lives transformed and helping clients embrace the hope and good plans in store for them.

We will begin rebranding our logo to reflect the new name change. However, our legal name will remain "Ashland Care Center, Inc."

PARK STREET BRETHREN GRANT LAUNCHES MEN'S MINISTRY

God is on the move! While listening to a song a while back, these words rang in my heart. The song simply says, "God is on the move in many mighty ways, God is on the move, on the move Hallelujah! God is on the move, on the move today!" The Ashland Pregnancy Care Center is blessed to announce that God is on the move within our ministry to the families of Ashland County. This past month, largely due to a generous gift from Park Street Brethren Church, we were able to lay the groundwork for a men's mentoring program.

This program is designed to help the male counterparts of our female clients to become the men and dads God has designed for them to be. We thank God for Pastor Andrew Foster, who volunteered to direct this ministry with the assistance of pastor and APCC board member, Travis McKenzie. We look forward to seeing God move in a mighty way through the efforts of the men's mentoring ministry. We would ask that you continue to keep all of our clients, volunteers, staff, and board members in your prayers as this ministry grows for the glory of our God.

Barbasol Tunds Expansion of Parenting Classes

The Ashland Pregnancy Care Center has been selected as a recipient of Barbasol Foundation's Ashland Grant in the amount of \$5,000 in order to expand its parenting classes. Our goal is to support families with the training, education, and resources needed to thrive and care for a new baby. After conducting parenting classes for one year and reviewing evaluations from our clients, it was evident that there is a need to expand and offer a second parenting class. Beginning in September, we will offer two 6-week parenting classes. Parenting Class 1 will focus on preparing for baby's arrival (boot camp, car seat and home safety, and building blocks for safe home environment). Parenting Class 2 will focus on after baby's arrival (early childhood development, positive discipline, budgeting, and love languages). Both classes will offer an incentive promoting safe sleep and safe travel in the form of a new Pack 'n Play and travel system (stroller and car seat combo) for 20 families who complete each 6-week class. Community leaders with professional knowledge and experience will also help teach specific class topics.

Thanks to the help of the Ashland County Community Foundation Women's Fund, which is making it possible to help us better reach, relate to, and enhance counseling sessions to millennials by investing in tablets and a new *Before You Decide: Live* app. This new technology creates an interactive, visual experience for the client to learn and make an informed decision about pregnancy options including abortion, adoption, parenting, and marriage. With 88% of abortions occurring in the first 12 weeks of pregnancy, and the most vulnerable to abortion — women and men in their 20s, we can intervene at a critical time

with tools at our fingertips that clients can relate to. The app features short

videos explaining abortion procedures and risks, images of life in the womb through all stages of pregnancy, quizzes, full Gospel presentation, and so much more. It's is the perfect companion to the *Before You Decide* magazine resource, which expands on the info in the app. The new technology has been created and approved by our affiliate, Care Net.
