Ashland Pregnancy Care Center's annual Sanctity of Human Life Sunday Community Service took place on January 21, hosted by Bethel Baptist Church in Savannah. More than 350 like-minded people gathered together for prayer and worship, led by Cross Connect Church. There were more than 25 different Ashland county churches represented, 8 parachurch ministries, and local elected officials. The love offering totaled \$5,649.16.

Wisconsin couple and guest speakers, Mark and Cori Salchert, are the parents of 8 children and have served as

foster parents for 7 terminally-ill children in the last 4 years, loving and caring for them as they prepare to die. In 2013, the Salcherts first adopted a 2-week-old girl they named Emmalynn, who died in Cori's arms after 50 days. Cori is a former bereavement nurse who now cares for Charlie, a 3-year-old boy who suffers from irreversible brain damage. The Salcherts adopted Charlie when he was 4 months old. Doctors expected him to die before the age of 2. Cori explains, "Charlie is not valuable because he's productive, he's not valuable because he's going to get up and do chores... Charlie is valuable because he is made in the image of God...Love is the game changer. He is thriving because he is loved."

Local artist Rachel Justice presented a live painting. The program began with greetings from Ashland County Ministerial Association President, Pastor Mike Futrell. Scripture readings were presented by Pastors Scot Myers (Ashland Christian) and Keith Tyson (Ashland Brethren in Christ). Rev. Frank Taylor (Loudonville First Baptist) gave an opening prayer, and Pastor Jon Hall (Ashland Grace Brethren) recognized special guests. Executive Director Melanie Miller, ultrasound sonographer Mandi Ross, and mom-to-be Mackenzie Miller shared a video of 18-week baby Lincoln, highlighting his beating heart and movement. Todd and Kelly Marshall (Ashland University & Mayor's Office), introduced the guest speaker and their longtime friends. Pastor John Bouquet (Bethel Baptist) challenged the crowd to give generously and Youth Pastor Sam Speck closed the service in prayer.


